


Book Week ~ Saturday 22 August - Friday 28 August 2015 Books light up our world





#### STEM in the Junior School

On Wednesday 22nd July, students from our school (year 3-6) were lucky enough to have had the opportunity of participating in an Out of the Box Workshop. They experienced Maths as they have never seen it before...

Inquisitive Minds is a Sydney based educational business, which focuses on creating positive mathematical experiences for students in Primary and Secondary Schools. The Mathematical Association of NSW is the professional body for mathematics teachers. Their innovative workshops reinforce classroom learning and have been designed to improve students' attitude and performance in Maths.

As a joint initiative, they have developed an in school activity named *Out of the Box*. During this incursion, students participated in an interactive lesson on strategic problem solving. They then worked on a series of original problems in a hands-on maths relay. *Out of the Box* workshops focus on WORKING MATHEMATICALLY. Students engage in 'fun' hands-on problem solving as they learn new strategies and work together in a problem-solving relay.

**ENGAGE** with maths activities and brain teasers which demonstrate the value of approaching problems strategically.

**LEARN** a range or problem solving strategies in an interactive mini-lesson

**SELECT AND APPLY** appropriate problem solving strategies as they participate in a hands-on Maths relay.

We are very much looking forward to sharing in the next Newsletter, the amazing work completed on this day.


